

## About the Nāhululeihiwakuipapa Subcommittee

<u>Nāhululeihiwakuipapa</u> is a subcommittee under the Hawai'i Conservation Alliance. The Alliance has formed several subcommittees to develop and support implementation of programs or activities described in their Strategic Action Plan. The Nāhululeihiwakuipapa subcommittee develops and implements projects that cultivate and model conservation leadership in Hawai'i using trans-disciplinary strategies, generational bridging, and Hawaiian Values to support the growth of future generations of environmental stewards. They are guided by a road map that is evaluated and updated every few years.

The subcommittee focuses on two main events and activities: <u>Nāhululeihiwakuipapa Emerging</u> <u>Professionals Workshop</u> at the Hawai'i Conservation Conference and the <u>Pūlama Kuamo'o</u> <u>Mentorship Program</u> at the Hawai'i Conservation Conference.
